SUNDAY

JESUS' TRIUMPHANT ENTRANCE INTO JERUSALEM

Matthew 21:1-11; Luke 19:28-40; Mark 11:1-11; John 12:12-19

JESUS CURSES THE FIG TREE ON THE WAY INTO THE CITY

Matthew 21:18-22

MONDAY

JESUS WEEPS OVER JERUSALEM

Luke 19:41-44

JESUS CLEANSSES THE TEMPLE FOR THE SECOND TIME IN HIS MINISTRY

Mark 11:15-19; Luke 19:45-48

TUESDAY

JESUS FINDS THE FIG TREE WITHERED; TEACHES ON FAITH

Mark 11:20-25

WEDNESDAY

SILENT DAY

There is no record in the Gospels, but there is much activity as Jesus prepares for the Last Supper, and Judas & the Sanhedrin prepare for Jesus' arrest.

THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE; JESUS' AGONY

BETRAYAL BY JUDAS; ARREST BY THE SANHEDRIN

Matthew 26:47-56; John 18:1-11

FRIDAY

THE TRIALS OF JESUS

- First Trial, before Annas
- Second (& Primary) Trial, before the Sanhedrin—Jesus is condemned, misused
- Third Trial, immediately at dawn
- Fourth Trial, before Pilate
- Fifth Trial, before Herod
- Sixth Trial, before Pilate
 - Jesus is scourged
- Jesus bears his cross to the gate on the north side of the city & is crucified around 9am

Matthew 26:57-27:44; Mark 14:53-15:32;
Luke 22:54-23:43; John 18:12-19:27

THE DEATH OF THE GOD-MAN

- About 3pm, the veil is torn, rocks split; some graves are opened & people raised
- Jesus' side is pierced
- Passover lambs slain in the Temple
- Jesus is buried by sundown

Luke 23:44-56; John 19:28-42

JESUS' SEVEN SAYINGS FROM THE CROSS

"Father, forgive them" (Luke 23:34)
"Today...with me in paradise" (Luke 23:43)
"Woman, behold your son" (John 19:26-27)

"My God, My God..." (Mark 15:34)
"I thirst" (John 19:28)
"It is finished" (John 19:30)
"Into your hands..." (Luke 23:46)

SATURDAY

**AT THE REQUEST OF THE JEWISH LEADERSHIP,
PILATE GRANTS A GUARD & SETS A SEAL ON THE TOMB OF JESUS**

Matthew 27:62-66

SUNDAY

**JESUS CHRIST RISES FROM THE DEAD &
MAKES APPEARANCES ON THE DAY OF HIS RISING TO:**

- Mary Magdalene & the other women who come to the tomb
Matthew 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-11; John 20:11-18
- Disciples on the road to Emmaus
Luke 24:13-35
- Simon Peter (nowhere recorded, but alluded to in Luke 24:33-34)
