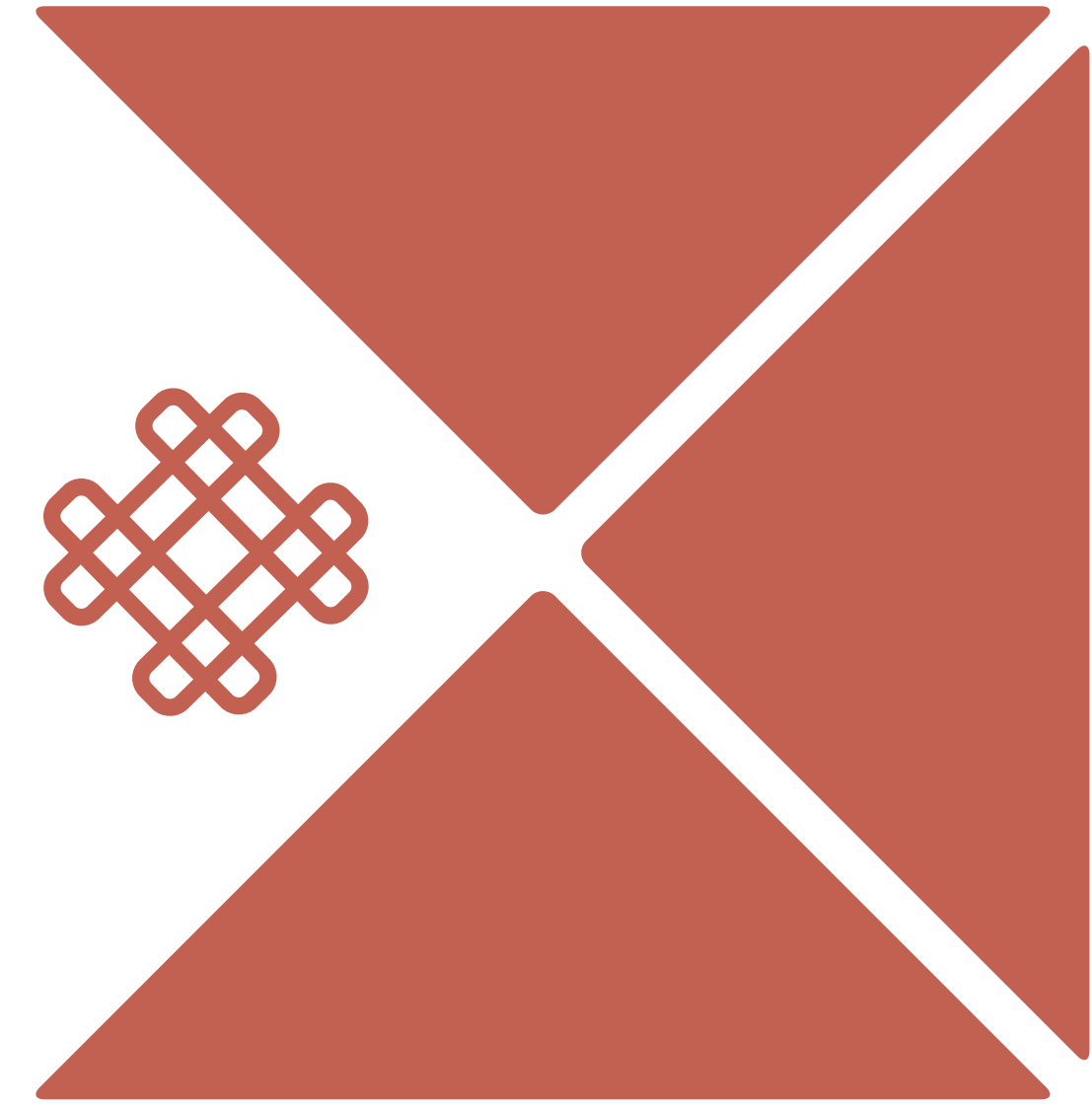

Context

1. The term “*follow me*” is not used to refer to what one must do to become a member of the twelve, but rather what any person must do to become a follower of Jesus.

2. Jesus' followers are not called to study the law, but to follow Him.

**3. Jesus was not calling them into
a partnership of equals,
but to be His followers and servants.**

**We don't come alongside Jesus;
we get behind Him and follow Him.**

4. The Kingdom of God has come and you must drop everything, because entering the Kingdom is more important than even life itself.

5. You must identify with Jesus' mission.

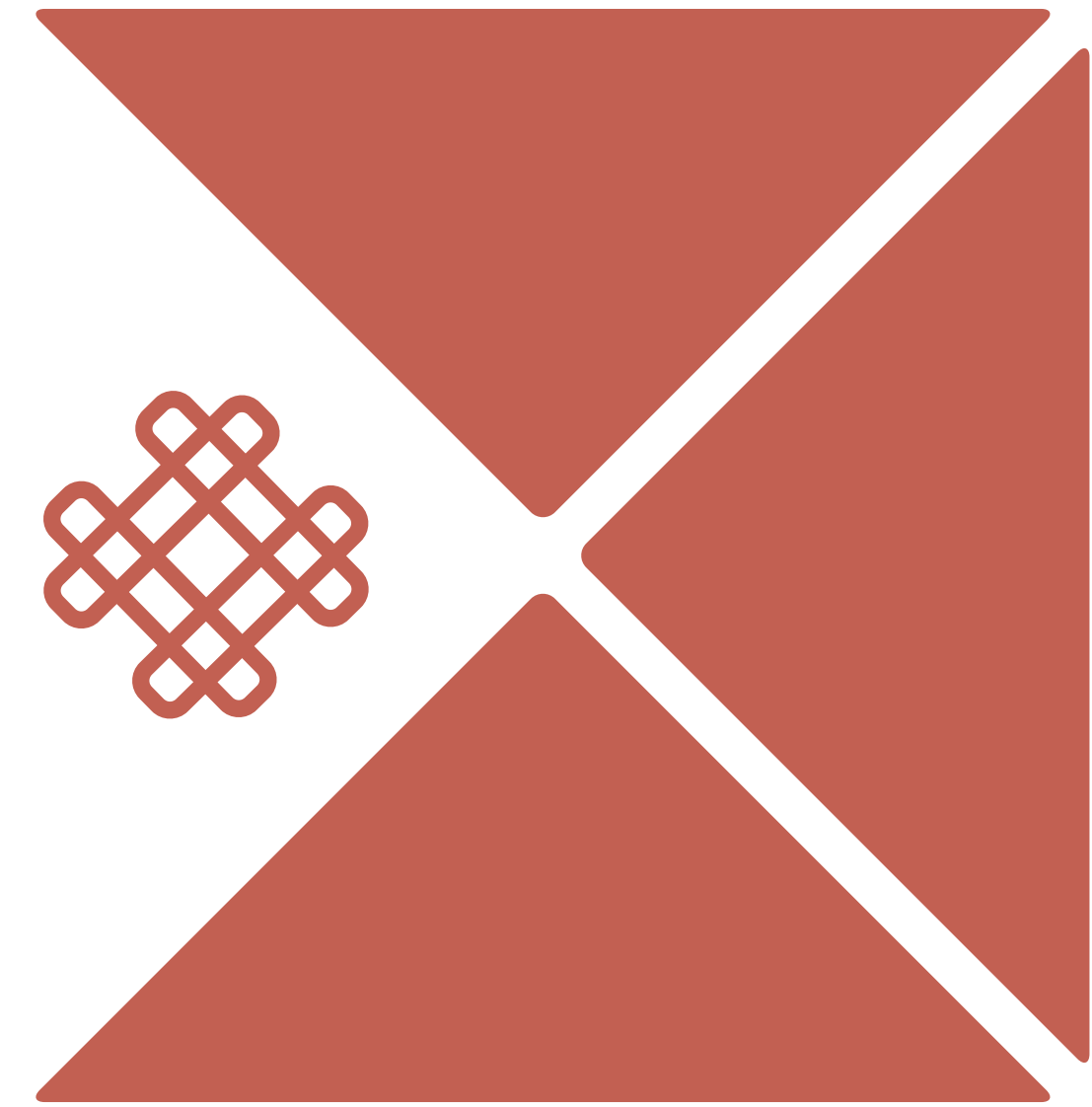
